#### ***Instructions' Card for the "Characters" for Mohammed***

##### **Card 1**

##### **You are Mohammed's Friend**

Your friend is starting a new life in this country.

You believe in his success because he is a great person, hard-worker, good husband and father, and you know that he needs your support because his family stayed in his country and he is alone here.

You are also an immigrant and you know how to overcome the obstacles. You can give good advice and help him. You also can motivate him, saying how you like him and his family, and believe in his success.

By being advised by the facilitator, begin to act according to this character. What you should do:

**You must help him to pile matchboxes, as many as possible, by giving right instructions and encouragement words.**

You can give him verbal instructions but you can touch him with your hands.

### Card 2

#### You are the Mohammed's employer

Mohammed, an immigrant from Egypt, is working for you although you know that he hasn't got official papers. His illegal situation is profitable for you: you can pay him a lower wage and demand him to work more hours, because he needs to earn more money.

You know that he is competent and a hard-worker and you also know he would like to have a labour contract. You are willing to help him but only if he follows your instructions.

By being advised by the facilitator, begin to act according to this character. What you should do:

You will encourage him to go on working for you, in return for protection. You will tell him that you can help in obtaining official documents and keep his job but you have to **ask him at least two boxes (from those that are already piled). Otherwise you will give him wrong instructions.**

You can give him verbal instructions but you can touch him with your hands.

### Card 3

#### **You are Mohammed's wife**

Your husband went to a new country, looking for better conditions! You've stayed in your country, with your 2 children.

You know that your husband is a committed person, a hard-worker and will do everything for you and your family. You wish he will succeed because all of you depend on him.

But you need money to pay the rent, to guarantee the children's school and also to afford the medicines and treatments for the youngest who have a chronic illness.

You need to phone your husband to encourage him and ask him for sending money (at least 2 boxes).

You know it will be very difficult to him to do it, but he must do... Your youngster daughter need urgently her medicines, her health depend on him. You need to be persuasive.

By being advised by the facilitator, begin to act according to this character. What you should do:

**You phone your husband and help him to pile matchboxes as many as possible, but you need to ask him for 2 boxes! Be persuasive!**

You can give her verbal instructions but you can touch her with your hands.
